Frequently Asked Questions

We want to make sure that you have all the information you need for the upcoming results day so here are some frequently asked questions to help you prepare.

Do I need to bring ID with me when I collect my results?

If you are collecting your results you will not need to bring any ID with you.

Can I get someone to pick up my results for me?

Yes, however you will need to provide them with a signed letter stating that you allow this person to pick up your results on your behalf. Your nominated person will also need to provide photographic proof of their identity.

I won't be available to collect my results. What should I do?

Don't worry, any results that have not been collected will be posted home at the end of the day.

I can't attend results day but I need some advice about my results?

Will I be able to speak to anyone about my options if my grades are not what I was expecting?

Yes of course. If you have any questions or need help or advice after you have received your results, we will have staff on hand to help you decide on your next steps.

How were my results calculated?

We were asked to send Exam Boards Teacher Assessed Grades for each of your subjects, and these were evidenced by work/assessments you had completed.

We considered a range of things like your classwork and homework; your results in assignments and any mock exams; any non-exam assessment or coursework you might have worked on.
